## Registrar's Report

To the Board of Directors and Management of Boise Cascade, L.L.C.

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on management's assertion that the Alexandria Engineered Wood Products manufacturing facility met these requirements, based on our audit. We planned and performed our work in order to obtain reasonable, rather than absolute, assurance with respect to the information examined. We believe our examination provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.
